Day at the Show® is pleased to host you, family, and fans this Thanksgiving weekend for a truly memorable baseball experience. Thanks to Angels Baseball LP, we have been permitted to play baseball in one of the Jewels in the major league baseball crown.

Just a few ground rules so we are clear on what's needed.
The parking entrance is at the gate located at 2000 Gene Autry Blvd.
You may self-park at stadium at no charge.
Best parking is behind home plate near the large batting helmets.
Access to the stadium is the home plate entrance

Once at the gate, staff will check you in and direct you into the event.
Players, please hand in your signed waiver at the scorekeeper's table located at the player's entrance to the field.
Scorekeeper will have waiver forms available for players and batboys/girls.

The Stadium doors will open at 9:00 AM for our first game at 10 am..

Glass Containers and alcohol beverages are prohibited in the park.
Food containers must be small enough to fit under the guests' seat; containers larger than 16" x 16" are prohibited. All bags, backpacks, soft-sided containers, etc. are subject to search by staff.

Players are asked to warm up in the outfield grass, not the foul territory. Pitchers are to warm up in the bullpens.
Practice swings in the on-deck circle only, not on the grass.
Each team plan to take about twelve minutes for infield/outfield.
Visitors go first and home team stays on the field awaiting the first pitch.

Base coaches must wear helmets.

Games are timed at 3:00 hours. Be prepared to play more than nine innings regardless of the game's score.

Game start times are 10 am, 1:45PM, and 5:30 PM.

Teams are to vacate the dugouts as soon as possible after their game. Please help us start the next game on time.

We need to adhere to the Major league baseball rules, which limit 2 kids (as batboys/girls) in each dugout. You may rotate kids in and out of the dugout, but only 2, at all times.

Parents must sign a waiver for batboys/girls.

Helmets must be worn at all time and the batboy-girl must have a reasonable understanding of the game of baseball to avoid possible injury or delay of the game.

Scorekeepers, team Mom's and fans are to sit in the stands. We appreciate your help with this.

We expect all members and their fans to use acceptable behavior. Failure to comply may result in being escorted out of the park. Keep in mind that your behavior will directly affect future events at the Big A.

Please dispose of all garbage in the receptacles that are provided throughout the stands. We are responsible for cleaning up the park after the last game, so please do your part and help out.

The Park closes immediately after the last night game. Please be prepared to leave with very little notice if you attend the last game of the day.
